Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) 2023-24

Depending on household income, pupils born between 1st March 2004 and 30th September 2007 may be eligible for an Education Maintenance Allowance payment of £30 per week (paid fortnightly). Pupils born between 1st October 2007 and 29th February 2008 may be eligible for an award starting in January 2024 and can still apply now.
