It lets you view your qualification information, check personal details SQA hold for you and, if you're sitting exams, you can sign up to get your results sent by email / text. You'll need your SCN (Scottish Candidate Number) to sign up to MySQA – if you don't already know this, you can get it from the office. Go to www.mysqa.org.uk for more info
