Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) — Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) is a weekly payment of £30 for eligible young people (depending on household income), born between 1st March 2005 and 30th September 2008. Eligible pupils born between 1st October 2008 and 28th February 2009 can apply now for payments starting in January 2025. Applications should be made through the Fife Council website — search for Education Maintenance Allowance or EMA. In order to receive payments, eligible learners must meet the required standards of school attendance, as detailed in their EMA award letter.

Online Career Days — Career Days is a company that offers online careers days, for 13-18 year olds, in a variety of fields. These consist of advice on subject choices and university applications in the morning followed by online work experience in the afternoon. Participants receive a certificate. See <u>CareerDays.co.uk</u> for more information. Please note there is a £69 charge to take part in these online events.
